The Osceola County Public Safety Commission met in the courtroom at the Osceola County Courthouse, Sibley, Iowa (due to COVID-19 and social distancing), on Wednesday, December 9, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. for its regular monthly meeting.

Chairman Arlyn Pedley called the meeting to order with roll call at 5:30 P.M.

Motion was made by Jerry Johnson and seconded by Jerry Helmers to approve the agenda: which was emailed prior to the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by LeRoy DeBoer and seconded by Lynelle Thiner to approve the minutes of the November 12, 2020 meeting as printed; which were emailed prior to the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Claims were reviewed and discussed on the list, (due to Covid 19 the claims were not passed). Motion by Lynelle Thiner to approve the claims for payment, seconded by Jerry Johnson. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by LeRoy DeBoer and seconded by Patrick DeVries to set next month's meeting for January 6, 2021 at 5:30 P.M. (per Ia Code 28E.23 – present budget before Jan 10).

With no further discussion, Jerry Johnson made a motion to adjourn at 5:40 P.M., which was seconded by Lynelle Thiner. Motion carried unanimously.
