SAMHSA Grant

Sanford Health EMS Education (SHEMSE) was awarded a grant through the US Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) to provide education for rural ambulance services in your area and is partnering to hold free EMT classes in your area.



Information

The course lectures will be held using Video Instructor-Led Training (VILT) technology. This allows the student to participate from home while still being interactive.

The Spring class video lectures will be held Tuesday evenings from 6 – 10 PM starting on January 12th, 2021.

Practical skills labs will abide by all applicable covid restrictions and will meet Thursday evenings (6-10 PM) at either Thief River Falls Ambulance Service or Rock County Ambulance in Luverne. Hillsboro or Wheaton area students can attend lab in Fargo, including a weekend option.
