It was moved by DeBoer, second by VandeHoef to appoint Jerry Helmets as Supervisor Vice-Chairman for 2021. All vote Aye. Motion carried.

The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment with the following members present: Mike Schulte, Jerry Helmets, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson VandeHoef, and Ed Jones

Schulte moves to approve the January 4, 2021, agenda. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Helmets, second by Schulte to approve the December 22, 2020 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

VandeHoef moves to approve the Gazette-Tribune and The Ocheyedon Press – Melvin News as the county's official newspapers. Second by Helmets. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by VandeHoef, second by Helmets to appoint Mike Schulte to the Third Judicial District Department of Correctional Services. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Schulte moves to approve LeRoy DeBoer to the Northwest Iowa Area Solid Waste Agency board. Second by Helmets. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Roger Mouw, assistant engineer explained to the board where the projects were located and that they all have been completed. It was moved by Schulte, second by Helmets to approve Iowa Dot final vouchers for contracts 035794, 035333, and 035334. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Stephanie Neppl, economic development director told the board that someone verbally gave her an offer per acre for some of the undeveloped land at the Enterrpise Park. Neppl asked the board if they are interested in developing that area and if so she gave them options to consider. VandeHoef moves to start the legal process of selling land to the interested party. The motion died from lack of support. The board is not interested in pursuing to sell the undeveloped land at the Enterprise Park at this time.

Schulte moves to approve the promotion and salary increases for Seth Hofman as Chief Deputy with a salary of \$67,607; Matt Julius-Lieutenant Deputy/Jailer with a salary of \$61,616; and Nate Krikke – Sergeant Deputy/Jailer for a salary of \$61,616. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by DeBoer, second by Helmets to approve the appointment of Nyron Moore as Deputy/Jailer for a salary of \$53,264. All vote aye. Motion carried.
