The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at First Baptist Church Fellowship Hall in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Jerry Helmers, Mike Schulte, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson VandeHoef, and Ed Jones. Absent: None.

VandeHoef moves to approve the February 11, 2021 agenda with the deletion to discuss Tyler Avenue liquidated damages with Godberson-Smith Construction. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Schulte, second by DeBoer to approve February 5, 2021 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Schulte moves to appoint Gary Snow as Veteran Affairs Commissioner. Second by VandeHoef. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Helmers, second by Schulte to approve the ambulance write-off of \$265 for a patient who is deceased and has no estate. All vote aye. Motion carried.

The board met with department heads.

When reviewing the proposed FY 21/22 budget it was moved by Helmers, second by Jones to approve that the allocation to Upper Des Moines Opportunity for FY 21/22 will not be paid until they submit minutes from their board meetings to the county. All vote aye. Motion carried. Helmers moves to approve the submitted proposed FY 21/22 budgets. Second by Jones. Aye-Helmets, DeBoer, Schulte, Jones. Nay-VandeHoef. Motion carried.

It was moved by DeBoer, second by Jones to approve March 4, 2021 at 9 am as Property Tax Levy Public Hearing date. All vote aye. Motion carried.

VandeHoef moves to approve claims submitted by the auditor's office. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll registers from February 10 and 12 were reviewed.

VandeHoef gave an update on Northwest Iowa Care Connections. Jones gave an update on proposed legislation eliminating the practical experience requirement before an engineer can take the PE test.
