The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at the Osceola County Courthouse Courtroom Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Jerry Helmers, Mike Schulte, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson VandeHoef, and Ed Jones. Absent: None.

Helmets moves to approve the March 4, 2021 agenda. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by VandeHoef, second by Schulte to approve February 26, 2021 minutes with the addition that Nolan McGowan, county attorney informed the board that the K9 dog Hunter passed away and shared he valued his years of service to the county. He wanted to extend his condolences to the sheriff's office. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Rochelle Van Tilburg, auditor gave an update on the courtroom technology upgrades.

VandeHoef informed the board that Hancock County will not be joining Northwest Iowa Care Connections region.

Schulte talked with Scott Rinehart, interim engineer regarding the engineer's position. Rinehart suggested to increase the salary base to draw more interest.

Jones gave an update on Early Childhood Iowa.

A proposed property tax levy public hearing was held at 9 am. No oral or written comments were received. Public hearing closed. It was moved by Schulte, second by Jones to approve the following resolution:

Resolution #22- 20/21

Approval of FY 21/22 Maximum Property Tax Dollars

WHEREAS, the Osceola County Board of Supervisors have considered the proposed FY 21/22 county maximum property tax dollars for both General County Services and Rural County Services, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on county website and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was held on March 4th, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Osceola County that the maximum property tax dollars for General County Services and Rural County Services for FY 21/22 shall not exceed the following:

General County Services - \$3,007,221

Rural County Services - \$1,492,000

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in either General County Services or Rural County Services for FY 21/22 does not represent an increase of 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY 20/21.

By Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Schulte, Jones, Helmers, DeBoer. Nay- VandeHoef. Passed and adopted the 4th day of March, 2021.

VandeHoef moves to approve March 26, 2021 at 9 am for the FY 21/22 proposed budget public hearing date. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.
