The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 11:00 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Ed Jones (via phone), Mike Schulte, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson VandeHoef (via phone), and Jerry Helmers. Absent: None.
