The Osceola County Public Safety Commission met in the meeting room at the Osceola County Public Safety building, Sibley, Iowa on Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at 5:30 P.M. for its regular monthly meeting.

Chairman Arlyn Pedley called the meeting to order with roll call at 5:30 P.M.

Motion was made by Jerry Johnson and seconded by LeRoy DeBoer to approve the agenda; which was emailed prior to the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.
