The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following member present: Ed Jones, Jayson Vande Hoef, LeRoy DeBoer, and via phone Jerry Helmers. Absent: Mike Schulte.

Vande Hoef moves to approve the May 12, 2022 agenda with the addition of appointing chairman pro tempore. Second by Jones. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Vande Hoef moves to approve the April 26, 2022 minutes. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by DeBoer second by Vande Hoef to appoint Jones as chairman pro tempore for all meeting being held on May 10th. All vote aye. Motion carried. Helmers excused himself from the meeting.

The Board met with department heads.

Marlene Boernsen talked about a Local Food and Community Self-Governance Ordinance. The ordinance would help individuals who sell at farmers market or sell directly to a customer have less regulations. Nolan McGowan, County Attorney reviewed the ordinance and submitted to the Board a revised version of the ordinance. McGowan had concerns about conflicts with state and federal regulations. Vande Hoef moves to table this ordinance and take it into future consideration. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Ernie Villanueva, Maintenance/Grounds Keeper told the Board that McDonald Roofing is hoping to come in a week to start the repairs on the roof.

It was moved by Vande Hoef, second by DeBoer to table the tree discussion on the courthouse grounds. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Keith Brann, Engineer updated the Board on the status of the truck purchase. Vande Hoef moves to approve the western star truck purchase from I-State Truck Center for \$129,620. Second by Jones. All vote aye. Motion carried.

A conference call with Brian Yung, Drainage Attorney, Ivan Droessler and Haley Kluesner, ISG reviewed drainage documents with the Board.

The Board received one audit bid from De Noble, Austin & Company PC for \$49,260 for three years. It was moved by Vande Hoef, second by DeBoer to award the audit bid to De Noble, Austin & Company. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll registers from May 4th, 5th and 6th were reviewed.

DeBoer moves to approve claim #1890 to Bosma Water Service. Second by Jones. Ayes-DeBoer, Jones. Nay-None. Abstain- Vande Hoef. Motion carried. It was moved by DeBoer, second by Vande Hoef to approve the remainder of the claims. All vote aye. Motion carried.
