

Sibley, Iowa

The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Mike Schulte, LeRoy DeBoer, and Ed Jones. Absent: Jayson Vande Hoef and Jerry Helmers.

DeBoer moves to approve the August 9th, 2022 agenda. Second by Jones. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jones, second by DeBoer to approve July 26, 2022 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Mike O'Connor, Operations Superintendent looked at the washout on the trails and made suggestions on how to repair it. Secondary road department will take care of the repairs. O'Connor also informed the Board about the bridge over the Ocheyedan river has logs trapped forcing the river towards the east abutment. The Board would also like the secondary road department to remove the logs.

The Board met with department heads.

A public hearing was held at 9 am for the second reading of Ordinance #59 Floodplain Management. There being no oral or written objections the public hearing was closed. Jones moves to approve the second reading of Ordinance #59 Floodplain Management. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jones, second by DeBoer to waive the third reading of Ordinance #59 Floodplain Management. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the amended application for participation in the national flood insurance program. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye.

It was moved by Jones, second by DeBoer to approve the first reading of Ordinance #60 Establishing Fees and Bonding Requirement for Work within Osceola County Right of Way. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to set August 23rd at 9:30 am as the public hearing date for the second reading of Ordinance #60 Establishing Fees and Bonding Requirement for Work within Osceola County Right of Way. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

The Board discussed the proposed options for an easement at the Enterprise Park per a request from Chris Hurlburt of Snap-On Tools. Hurlburt would like an easement to run North along his property line so he can access his northern parcel. Jones recommended that the county do an ingress/egress driveway easement to Hurlburt. It was moved by Jones, second by DeBoer to table this discussion until next meeting. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the non-profit contract with Western Iowa Tourism. Second by Schulte. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll registers from July 27th, July 29th, August 2nd and August 10th were reviewed.

It was moved by Jones, second by DeBoer to approve the payment of claims submitted by the auditor's office.
