ALL POLLS WILL OPEN AT 7:00 A.M. AND WILL CLOSE AT 8:00 P.M.

THIS ELECTION PERTAINS ONLY TO VOTERS WITHIN THE HMS SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES FOR THE FOLLOWING PRECINCTS:

ASHTON PRECINCT: City of Ashton, Gilman Township and West ½ of Goewey Township - **POLLING PLACE LOCATION CHANGE- MELVIN AMERICAN LEGION BUILDING, 225 MAIN St, MELVIN, IA 51350**

MAY CITY PRECINCT: Sections 13-36 of Allison Township and Sections 1-18, 22-27, and 34-36 of Harrison Township - **POLLING PLACE LOCATION CHANGE – MELVIN AMERICAN LEGION BUILDING, 225 MAIN St, MELVIN, IA 51350**

MELVIN PRECINCT: City of Melvin, East ½ of Goewey Township, Baker Township, and Sections 19-21 and 28-33 of Harrison Township. **MELVIN AMERICAN LEGION BUILDING – 225 MAIN ST., MELVIN, IA 51350**

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts, must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification or prove residence if required. 1) may have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by noon, September 19, 2022. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
