

Sibley, Iowa
September 27, 2022

The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Ed Jones, Mike Schulte, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson Vande Hoef, and Jerry Helmers. Absent: None.

Jones moves to approve the September 27, 2022 agenda. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jones, second by Schulte to approve September 20, 2022 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the October schedule as follows: October 11th, and 25th with claims being paid on the 11th and the 25th. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Mike O'Connor, Operations Superintendent explained the sprayer truck quote he received from C & R Supply, Inc for \$42,082.01. It was moved by Schulte, second by Jones to approve to purchase the sprayer truck from C & R Supply, Inc. All vote aye. Motion carried. O'Connor informed the Board since it takes about 2 years to get any equipment he is getting quotes for 2024 maintainer.

Keith Brann, Engineer explained that the DNR wanted his name removed from the previously approved resolution. It was moved by Schulte, second by Jones to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NUMBER # 13 22/23

WHEREAS, certain areas of Osceola County are subject to periodic flooding causing damages to properties within these areas; and

WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of Federally subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Board of Supervisors, to require the recognition and evaluation of flood hazards in all official actions relating to land use in areas having these hazards; and

WHEREAS, this body has the legal authority to adopt land use and control measures to reduce future flood losses pursuant to Chapter 335, Code of Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board hereby:

1. Assures the Federal Insurance Administration that it will enact as necessary, and maintain in force in those areas having flood hazards, adequate land use and control measures with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the Criteria set forth in Section 60 of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations,
2. Vests the Osceola County Engineer, with the responsibility, authority, and means to:
 - a. Assist the Federal Insurance Administrator, at his request, in his delineation of the limits of the area having special flood hazards.
 - b. Provide such information as the Administrator may request concerning present uses and occupancy of the flood plain areas.
 - c. Cooperate with Federal, State, and local agencies and private firms which undertake to study, survey, map, and identify flood plain areas, and cooperate with neighboring communities and the county with respect to management of adjoining flood plain areas in order to prevent aggravation of existing hazards.
 - d. When received from the Administrator, complete and submit those reports which advise the Administrator on the progress made within the community in the development and implementation of flood plain management measures.
 - e. Upon occurrence, notify the Administrator in writing whenever the boundaries of the community have been modified by annexation or loss of authority to adopt and enforce flood plain management regulations for a particular area. Included in such notification will be a map of the community, suitable for reproduction, which clearly delineates the new or deleted areas.
3. Appoints the Osceola County Engineer, to maintain for public inspection and to furnish upon request, for the determination of applicable flood insurance risk premium rates any certificates of flood-proofing and information on the elevation (in relation to North American Vertical Datum 1988) of the level of the lowest floor (including basement) of all new or substantially improved structures, and
4. Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the program.

Ayes- Schulte, Jones, DeBoer, Vande Hoef, Helmers. Nay-None. ADOPTED AND PASSED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Osceola, Iowa this 27th day of September, 2022.

Keith Brann, Engineer informed the Board that the DNR didn't approve the previously approved Ordinance #59 Floodplain Management. Some language was changed which the county did get prior approval for from the DNR but when reviewed the final ordinance the DNR rejected the ordinance language change. Jones moves to set October 11, 2022 at 9:15 am as the public hearing date for Amendment to Ordinance # 59 Floodplain Management. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Vande Hoef, second by Jones to appoint Dr. Garrett J. Sterk as Deputy Medical Examiner. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve Osceola County Elections Security Policy. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll registers from September 21st and 23rd were reviewed.

It was moved by Schulte, second by Jones to approve claim #454 to Bosma Water Service. Ayes- Schulte, Jones, DeBoer, Helmers. Nay-None. Abstain-Vande Hoef. Motion carried. Jones moves to approve the remainder of the claims submitted by the auditor's office. Second by Vande Hoef. Motion carried.

Jones reported he has received some complaints about the Ocheyedan River being pumped dry. He turned over the complaints to the DNR.
