The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Ed Jones, Mike Schulte, via phone- LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson Vande Hoef, and Jerry Helmers. Absent: None.

Schulte moves to approve the October 25, 2022 agenda. Second by Vande Hoef. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Vande Hoef, second by Schulte to approve October 18, 2022 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the November schedule as follows: November 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 22<sup>nd</sup> with claims being paid on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup>. A joint drainage district #3 public hearing continuation will also be held at 1 pm in Harris on November 22<sup>nd</sup>. Second by Schulte. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Schulte and Jones informed the Board that the Rescue American Plan Act committee are recommending that the rest of the allocation of \$1,007, 272 to be used to remodel the jail. Vande Hoef commented that he would like to see options for addressing the remodel as one project or doing it in phases. It was moved by Schulte, second by Jones to move forward with the jail remodel project. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Schulte, second by Vande Hoef to proceed to enter into a contract with Rick A. Weidner and John Hanson for the jail remodel project. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the appointment for Mark Zuraff as equipment operator for \$23.69 per hour. Second by Vande Hoef. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jones, second by Schulte to approve appointment for Reggie Ommen as maintenance/groundskeeper for a salary of \$41,360. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve appointment for Richard Kruckman as part-time custodian for \$17.17 per hour. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Vande Hoef to approve the pay increase for Austin Butler to \$58,112. Second by Jones. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll register from October 21<sup>st</sup> was reviewed.

Jones moves to approve claims #631 and #632 to Bosma Water Service. Second by Schulte. Ayes- Jones, Schulte, DeBoer, Helmers. Nay- None. Abstain-Vande Hoef. Motion carried. It was moved by Schulte, second by Helmers to pay the remainder of the claims submitted by the auditor's office. All vote aye. Motion carried. Jones moves to amend the motion where approving Bosma Water Service to include claim # 672 to Bosma Water Service. Second by Schulte. Ayes- Jones, Schulte, DeBoer, Helmers. Nay- None. Abstain-Vande Hoef. Motion carried.
