The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 8:45 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Ed Jones, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson Vande Hoef, Jerry Helmers and Mike Schulte. Absent: None.

DeBoer moves to approve the January 24, 2023 agenda. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by DeBoer, second by Helmers to approve January 10, 2023 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones moves to approve the appointment of Chris Wynia as Viola Township Clerk term ending 12/31/2023. Second by Vande Hoef. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Jones, second by Helmers to approve the amendment to Kwik Trip, Inc class E retail alcohol license. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Helmerts moves to approve the purchase of FVS precinct scanners for a cost of \$45,762 and use the 3-year interest free financing option beginning in FY 23/24. Second by Jones. Ayes- Helmers, Jones, DeBoer, Schulte, Nay- Vande Hoef. Motion carried.

Nick Schmalen, Conservation Director gave FY 21/22 Conservation Board annual report.

Payroll registers from January 11th and 13th were reviewed.

It was moved by Jones, second by Helmers to approve claim# 1225 to Bosma Water Service. Ayes-Jones, Helmers, DeBoer, Schulte. Nay-None. Abstain- Vande Hoef. Motion carried. Jones moves to approve the remainder of the claims. Second by DeBoer. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Melissa Loehr and Marlee Christoffel from Care Connections of Northern Iowa gave the Board updates on services provided to Osceola County residents.

The Board reviewed FY 23/24 budgets.

Ryan Berven, Assured Partners and Brad Holtan, ISAC presented employee benefits for FY 24. For FY 24 the HSA plan the single deductible is going from \$2,800 to \$3,000. The HRA plan the RX out of pocket increased from \$1,000/\$2,000 to \$1,250/\$2,500 and the specialty drug copay increased to \$45/\$75/\$150 instead of \$45. The Board discussed changing dental plans from plan 2 to plan 4.

Vande Hoef talked to Board about considering increasing the general basic levy per Iowa Code 331.426 due to all of the state unfunded mandates.

Jones reported on the ECI quarterly report on I-Smile program.
