

Sibley, Iowa

The Osceola County Board of Supervisors met pursuant to law and adjournment at 9:00 am at Osceola County Courthouse Board Room in Sibley, Iowa with the following members present: Mike Schulte, Jerry Helmers, LeRoy DeBoer, Jayson Vande Hoef, and Ed Jones. Absent: None.

DeBoer moves to approve the May 7, 2024 agenda. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Schulte, second by DeBoer to approve April 23, 2024 minutes. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Helmets moves to re-appoint Winifred Krogman to the Veteran Affairs Commission. Second by Vande Hoef. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Keith Brann, Engineer upon a request from the Iowa DOT to separate the FY28 HMA project into three distinct projects based on funding type in the county five-year program presented an updated program. Brann stated that no other changes were made in the project limits or cost that was previously approved. It was moved by Helmers, second by Schulte to approve the FY 25 County Five Year Program. All vote aye. Motion carried

The Board met with department heads.

The WW 1 Monument relocation was discussed. Vande Hoef moves to relocate the WW 1 Monument so that it would be centered north/south with the Civil War Monument and east/west with the sidewalk near the west side of the courthouse. Second by Helmers. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Payroll registers from May 1,2, and 3 were reviewed.

It was moved by Schulte, second by DeBoer to approve claims 1828, 1829, 1830 and 1888 to Bosma Water Service. Ayes- Schulte, DeBoer, Helmers, Jones. Nay – None. Abstained – Vande Hoef. Motion carried. Helmers moves to pay the remainder of the claims. Second by Schulte. All vote aye. Motion carried.

Jones went over meeting guidelines stating that Parliamentary Procedures have always been used and should continue to be followed. Jones stated that special meetings can be called by the board chair or 3 board members who make their requests in writing to the Chairman of Board. Jones talked with the Iowa Public Records Board about Resolution #32 23/24 that was approved at the April 13, 2024 meeting; Jones stated that since it wasn't on the agenda it needs to be reapproved at the next meeting. Jones suggested that the auditor's summary that was approved on April 13, 2024 should not have been approved by the Board but should remain in the auditor's notes.
