

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given to the eligible electors of Osceola County, Iowa that there will be a **PRIMARY ELECTION** in Osceola County, Iowa, at the regular polling place in each of the eight (8) voting precincts of said county on

TUESDAY, JUNE 4, 2024

The polls will open at all voting precincts as listed below at 7 a.m. and will close at 8:00 p.m. as provided by law.

ASHTON PRECINCT: Ashton Legion Community Building-321 3rd St., Ashton, IA

HARRIS PRECINCT: Harris Civic Center 122 Main St. S, Harris, IA

MAY CITY PRECINCT: May City Fire Station- 6656 Frederick Ave., May City, IA

MELVIN PRECINCT: Melvin Legion Hall – 225 Main St., Melvin, IA

OCHEYEDAN PRECINCT: Ocheyedan Town Hall – 869 Main St., Ocheyedan, IA

OSCEOLA 1 PRECINCT: Sibley Senior Center -East Doors – 612 8th St., Sibley, IA

OSCEOLA 2 PRECINCT: Sibley Senior Center- West Doors – 612 8th St., Sibley, IA

OSCEOLA 3 PRECINCT: United Methodist Church – 700 11th Ave NE, Sibley, IA

Iowa law states that in order to vote in the Primary Election, you must choose either the Democratic, Libertarian, or Republican Ballot §43.38-Code of Iowa. You may declare or change your party affiliation at the polls on Election Day according to Section §43.42- Code of Iowa, by noting that change when you sign the election register provided by the Precinct Election Officials.

This notice is published in compliance with §49.53-Code of Iowa.

All polling locations are accessible to all voters including those with disabilities, §49.21(1) – Code of Iowa. Curbside voting is available during in-person absentee and on election day at the voters polling location. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day- and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required may 1) have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by 12:00 noon on Thursday, June 6, 2024. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
